NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, by the undersigned County Auditor and ex-officio Clerk of the County Commissioners of Kitsap, Washington, that in pursuance of a resolution adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of said County and State, on the 15th day of March A. D. 1920, to submit to the qualified voters of the following described territory, situated in said County and State, the proposition of creating a port district comprising the territory described as follows, to-wit:

Sections 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, W¹/₂ 10, Section 15 except the N.E. ¹/₄ thereof; 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, the North one-half of 29 and 30 all in Township 25 N. Range 1 East, W.M. also Sections 1, 12, 13, 24, and the North one-half of 25 all in Township 25 North, Range 1 West, W.M.

That a special election will be held at the polling place at Silverdale in the above described territory on Tuesday, April 13th, between the hours of 1 P.M. and 8 P.M. of said day.

The object of this election is to submit to the qualified electors of the hereinbefore described territory, the proposition of creating a port district comprising the territory hereinbefore described. There is also to be elected at said election one Port Commissioner from each of the following port commissioners districts as follows, to-wit:

Commissioner District Number One, comprising Sections 1, 12, 13, 24, North ¹/₂ of 25 of Township 25 North Range 1 West and Sections 6, 7, 18, 19, and North ¹/₂ of 30, Township 25 North Range 1 East.

Commissioner District Number Two, comprising Sections ~~2~~ 4, 5, 8, 9, 16, 17, 20, and North ¹/₂ of 29, Township 25 North Range 1 East W.M.

Commissioner District Number Three, comprising West ¹/₂ of 10, Section 15 except the N.E. ¹/₄ thereof, 21 and 22, Township 25 North Range 1 East W.M.
