

PORT OF SILVERDALE
RESOLUTION NO. 2020 - 03
ADOPTING 2020 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN


WHEREAS:

1. In October 2007 the Port of Silverdale ("Port") adopted Resolution No. 2007-06 updating the Port's Comprehensive Plan, and in March 2014 the Port adopted Resolution No. 2014-01 again updating the Port's Waterfront Comprehensive Plan.
2. Pursuant to the Port's Comprehensive Plan, in 2014 and 2016 the Port acquired additional properties along Byron Street, thereby enabling the next planning phase of specific uses and designs in the waterfront area of Port property south of Byron Street in Silverdale.
3. In 2016 and 2017 the Port got input from persons with residential, commercial, sailing, rowing, power boating, hand powered watercraft, festivals, passive enjoyment and other interests to assist the Port in identifying specific uses and their possible locations on Port properties.
4. In 2018 the Port advertised through a competitive process for a planning consultant to assist in updating the Comprehensive Plan, and in 2019 the Port retained the services of Rice Fergus Miller and Art Anderson Associates (Planning Team) for this purpose. The Planning Team met on numerous occasions with the Port Commissioners, interested citizens, experts in environmental matters, and other governmental entities, and in August 2019 presented the Port with a draft revised Comprehensive Plan.
5. The Port retained the services of a professional grant writer so that the proposed plan would meet grant requirements for future implementation. The draft plan was augmented with a Capital Improvement element for this purpose and in January 2020 was approved for grant purposes upon adoption by the Port.
6. The Port is actively pursuing with Kitsap County Public Works the possible relocation of the county sewer pump station onto Port property and into a joint use facility that is in a predesign phase involving a series of community meetings.



ADOPTED by the Port Commission of the Port of Silverdale, Kitsap County, Washington at its regular open public meeting held on February 20, 2020.


